NMM Board Member, Kent Carruthers, and Norman Q&A

The following is a question and answer discussion between Kent Carruthers, a member of the NMM Board of Directors, and Norman regarding this Ministry.

Kent: “How long have you served as an evangelist?”

Norman: “We began in 1979, and have completed 30 years.”

Kent: “What are some of the major needs you’ve observed during your years of traveling ministry?”

Norman: “There are unsaved people who bear the guilt of their sins, with no assurance of eternity in Heaven. There are Christians who are living a shallow, nominal life of self-will. There are churches that are stagnant, apathetic and declining. And there are pastors who are stressed and discouraged.”

Kent: “How is the Lord using you to meet these needs?”

Norman: “God opens doors for me to preach; and the Holy Spirit applies the messages, driving the scriptures into individual hearts, and leading people to a point of decision.”

Kent: “What are the results?”

Norman: “Unsaved people receive Jesus Christ as Savior and are forgiven. Christians make a total commitment of their lives to God’s Will and are filled with the Holy Spirit. Congregations are awakened to fresh vision and renewal. And pastors are helped and encouraged.”

Kent: “What trends have you noticed among churches?”

Norman: “Sometimes it’s difficult to distinguish between a trend and a fad. But I have observed that many churches have omitted revivals, and others are opting for “Sunday-only” special services.”

Kent: What solutions are you pursuing?”

Norman: “We are expanding the availability of our Ministry to a wide arena of evangelical churches.”

Kent: What challenges currently face the Ministry?”

Norman: “We need to be fully funded. The free-will offerings from churches provide about 40% of our annual expenses. Some churches are having financial difficulty. We must raise the remaining 60%. We need Ministry Partners to join hands with us by prayer and financial support.”

Kent: “After 30 years in evangelism, how is your stamina and perseverance for the future?”

Norman: “My heart is still ignited by God’s Call to this work. I remain optimistic and committed; I’m challenged by this great Cause! I really appreciate the great help that Vickie, our Board and our Partners all provide. I am thankful to the Lord for His ongoing guidance and blessings. Our endurance and persistence result from a clear sense of our purpose and a relentless grip on our mission.”
